Why the VI?

- Agreed with Government as the alternative to a possible £125m pa tax on pesticides
- A better more targeted way to deliver the environmental improvements





UK Environmental Impacts

- Water
 - 7-9% surface water samples >0.1ppb
 - Phenoxys, Triazines, Substituted ureas
 - Groundwater... concerns
 - Treatment costs
- Biodiversity
 - Farmland Birds
 - 80% decline in populations since 1970s
 - Grey Partridge, Corn Bunting, Yellowhammer









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


NSTS - Sprayer Testing


- Based on AEA scheme
- AEA administered
- Boom sprayers and granule applicators
- Special sprayer tester training
- 57% sprayers tested need prior work to pass test
 - nozzles
 - leaking joints
