

SCI Young Lipid Scientist Award 2019

Deadline for applications: Friday 3 May 2019 Presentations by shortlisted candidates: Monday 3 June 2019

This award is to recognise excellence and emerging talent in research related to lipids, in any field across the physical and life sciences and engineering. Example areas include, **but are not restricted to**: neuroscience, digestion and metabolism, crystallisation of triacylglycerols, lipid oxidation, functioning of phospholipid membranes, compositional analysis, processing and disease prevention.

Applicants are requested to submit a 300 word abstract of the results of their research, on a Lipids related theme, to awards@soci.org by the closing date of **Friday 3 May 2019**. Applicants must currently be studying for a PhD within the UK.

Shortlisted candidates will be asked to present a 15 minute oral presentation of their research, with accompanying PowerPoint presentation, during the SCI Young Lipid Scientist Award event on **Monday 3 June 2019**. All those invited to give oral presentations will be refunded reasonable travel expenses (2nd class off-peak return rail fare), and also receive one year's complimentary membership of SCI.

The winner will receive a prize of £100, a certificate, and an opportunity to give an oral presentation at Euro Fed Lipid Congress 2019 in Seville, Spain, for which SCI would cover expenses up to the value of £400 to attend.
