I graduated in chemistry and my first job in industry was at Glaxo as a synthetic chemist. After 2 years I moved to a publicly funded research institute and then undertook a PhD. I spent 20 years in publicly funded research before moving to be Research Director at Leatherhead Food Research. I have held senior positions in three companies and am currently a Specialist with the Knowledge Transfer Network.

I was a member of the SCI Food Group Committee. I am a member of the SEG and honorary treasurer of the Group.

I have Board experience (Leatherhead) and of relaunching a business. I have corporate experience and experience of good governance, strategy and leadership. I was a member of the Mars Science Leadership Team (chaired by the Chief Science Officer of Mars Inc.) and have been a senior manager/Director in public and commercial organisations. I have managed large budgets (>\$20M per annum) and have worked in the UK, Europe and the US. I have an excellent network at senior level in the UK, US and Europe. I am a member of key ILSI committees including the Science Advisory Committee. I have substantial links to industry, to BEIS and to UKRI. I am UK representative and secretary of the IUPAC Committee of Chemical Industry.
