CHAIRMAN'S HIGHLIGHTS 2017/2018

The Chair reviewed the highlights from 2017/2018. He opened by commenting on what a tremendous asset the Belgrave Square headquarters is to the Society, with many recent enhancements, and noted how well it is used by important external organisations such as Innovate UK. He went on to reflect on how the many successful activities over the year have illustrated the key values of SCI, as a catalyst for innovation, having a passion for science, supporting careers and nurturing talent, and being a valued community for a growing network of stakeholders.

The Chair thanked the retiring Trustees and Committee members whose terms had ended.

FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS

The Honorary Treasurer, Dr Geoffrey Fowler, gave a brief financial review of 2017/18. It was noted that publications, the premises and conferences remained the main sources of income for the Society. The Honorary Treasurer noted that SCI had had another very successful financial year and thanked staff, members and volunteers for the support and engagement received over the past year.

MEMBERSHIP SURVEY RESULTS: Dr David Witty, Chair Membership Committee

The Chair of the Membership Committee, Dr David Witty, gave a brief presentation on the results of the recent membership survey. He thanked members for their contribution to the survey and confirmed that all suggestions would be considered and encouraged any further comments to be made to the Membership Committee for consideration.

SCI STRATEGY, Sharon Todd, SCI Executive Director

The Executive Director, Sharon Todd, gave a short presentation on SCI's Strategy and priorities going forward. She described the significant progress made by the Society and the continued efforts to grow the membership and develop new activities. Priorities going forward would be (i) to continue to grow membership (ii) to continue to engage in the UK Industrial Strategy (iii) to launch new programmes to support early and mid career members and (iv) to continue to promote science based innovation and industry. Over the next few months new IT infrastructure would come into operation and a new website launched. It was also noted that a new journal was under consideration.

The Executive Director noted the significant input and hard work of all members, staff and volunteers and thanked them for their efforts.

There being no more business, the Chairman of the Board of Trustees declared the meeting closed.
