Professor Greet Van Eetvelde - INEOS

Greet Van Eetvelde joined INEOS in 2011 as Group Head of Energy and Innovation Policy. Her responsibilities include steering the pan-INEOS carbon and energy network and directing research and innovation projects that tackle grand industrial climate challenges. Greet represents INEOS in the Cefic programme councils Climate and Energy as well as Research and Innovation. She is also INEOS' delegate in the SPIRE partnership, and is chairwoman of SusChem Switzerland.

Appointed Professor at Gent University (UGent) in 2000, Greet continues to lead the Energy and Cluster Management research group at the faculty of Engineering and Architecture. After in parallel heading the university's Environmental department till 2006, she became director of UGent's Energy platform Power-Link as well as CEO of its Greenbridge science park till 2011. In April 2015 Greet was additionally assigned the position of visiting professor at EPFL in Switzerland, in the Industrial Process and Energy Systems Engineering group. Greet is EPOS Project Coordinator with the UGent ECM research group and likewise co-manages INEOS' partner activities in the Lavera and Hull clusters.

She holds engineering degrees in bioscience and chemistry, an advanced Master's degree in environmental sciences, and a PhD from Ghent University in Belgium. In 1994 she was granted a British Council fellowship at the Building Research Establishment in outer London.
