This award is to recognise excellence and emerging talent in research related to lipids, in any field across the physical and life sciences and engineering. Example areas include, but are not restricted to: neuroscience, digestion and metabolism, crystallisation of tri- acylglycerols, lipid oxidation, functioning of phospholipid membranes, compositional analysis, processing and disease prevention.

Shortlisted candidates will be notified by email on 19 May 2023 and will be asked to make a 15 minute oral presentation of their research at the SCI Young Lipid Scientist Award event on Friday 2 June 2023. All those invited to give oral presentations will be refunded reasonable travel expenses (2nd class off-peak return rail fare), and also receive one year's complimentary membership of SCI.

- £100 prize money and a certificate

- Expenses up to the value of £400 to enable them to present their winning work at an international conference (during 2022 or 2023).
