

20 SCI YOUNG LIPID SCIENTIST 21 AWARD

Organised by Lipids Group Committee

This award is to recognise excellence and emerging talent in research related to lipids, in any field across the physical and life sciences and engineering. Example areas include, but are not restricted to: neuroscience, digestion and metabolism, crystallisation of triacylglycerols, lipid oxidation, functioning of phospholipid membranes, compositional analysis, processing and disease prevention.

Shortlisted candidates will be notified by email on **4 June 2021** and will be asked to make a 15 minute oral presentation of their research by video conference at the SCI Young Lipid Scientist Award event 2021. All those invited to give oral presentations will receive one year's complimentary membership of SCI.

DESCRIPTION OF AWARD

- **£100 prize money** and a certificate
- One year's complimentary membership of SCI (worth £25)
- Opportunity to give an oral presentation at the Euro Fed Lipid Congress 2021 in Leipzig, Germany, for which SCI would cover expenses up to the value of £400 to attend.
