GUIDANCE NOTES FOR MEMBERS STANDING FOR ELECTIONS - 2021

GET INVOLVED

SCI is continuing to focus on delivering our charitable objectives, working at the interface between science and industry, supporting and promoting scientific innovation into industry for the benefit of society. SCI carries out many activities in support of its charitable objectives and these cover awards, conferences and events, scientific publishing, careers support and policy and strategy work.

SCI relies on the support and involvement of its active and dedicated Members, who contribute their valuable time, experience and energy to developing and running many activities for the Society. All Governance Committee Members work as an integral part of the SCI team and successful applicants will find these important roles rewarding in that they support both the current operations and help shape the future of SCI.

If you feel you have relevant experience and a passion for promoting scientific innovation then please do consider standing for election. The Board of Trustees is keen to ensure diversity of representation across gender, race and age.

2021 POSITIONS

This year, the following positions are available:

6	Ordinary Members of the Board of Trustees
10	Ordinary Members of the Finance and Investments Advisory Committee (FIAC)
4	Ordinary Members of the Membership Sub Committee (MC)
2	Ordinary Members of the Publications Sub Committee (PC)
1	Ordinary Members of the Early Careers Sub Committee (ECC)

Across all the vacancies, it is expected that candidates will have either expertise relevant to the position for which they are standing, or an interest to develop their knowledge in the area. Members with existing experience as a Group Officer or member of an Editorial Board are encouraged to consider governance roles as a further step of engagement with the Society. Members interested in joining the governance structure as part of their personal or professional development are also encouraged to apply.

2021 DEADLINES

Nominations open on **Friday 23 April** and close at **midday Monday 24 May**. Please ensure your nominations are submitted by the deadline. *Nominations submitted after the 24 May cannot be accepted.*

PRINCIPLES OF GOOD GOVERNANCE

The Charity Commission sets out six principles of good governance required from a Trustee, and these are equally applicable to prospective Members of SCI's Advisory and Sub Committees:

- **Understand the role**
- **Deliver the mission**
- **Work as individuals and as a team**
- **Control effectively**
- **Behave with integrity**
- **Be open and accountable**

ELIGIBILITY

A candidate for election to any Governance Committee or to the Board of Trustees must be a fully paid SCI Member in good standing at the time of submitting the Nomination Form. Please note e-Members are not eligible to stand for elected posts.

COMPLETING THE NOMINATION FORMS

- Nominations are via an online nomination process. **You can start the process here.**
- Please read carefully the reference documents required for the governance positions and make sure you have any documents required.
- You will be required to provide a passport size photo image (high resolution JPEG) for your candidate profile, to be used for promotion on the day of the AGM. To check whether or not we already have your photo on file, please contact AGM support staff as soon as possible on 020 7598 1500 or AGM@soci.org
- Please check through your Nomination Form before submitting.

APPLICANTS FOR THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

In the case of Trustees there are legal obligations and liabilities, which are similar to those of a company director, and therefore the criteria for Trustee roles are more demanding.

Trustees are likely to have good knowledge of SCI and will need the relevant professional experience and personal qualities to be able to take on leadership and ambassadorial roles in the Society. A reference document outlining typical skills and competencies of a Trustee is available as part of the nomination application.

All nominees for Trustee positions must provide two completed Sponsor Forms as part of their nomination application. Both sponsors need to be fully paid SCI Members in good standing, and one must be a serving Member of BoT, FIAC, the Membership Committee or the Publications Committee at the time of the nomination being submitted.

The additional requirements for those applying for a Trustee role are:

- The Declaration of Eligibility form must be completed and signed. *Current Trustees re-standing for a Trustee role do not need to fill in an eligibility form.*
- Two completed Sponsor Statements are required, to be submitted at the time of application. Both sponsors need to be a fully paid SCI Members in good standing, and one must be currently serving on BoT, FIAC, the Membership Committee (MC) or Publications Committee (PC) at the time of the nomination being submitted. *Nominations cannot be accepted without accompanying Sponsor Forms. If you are keen to apply for a Trustee role but do not have a sponsor on one of the governance committees listed above please contact us at AGM@soci.org*

OTHER POINTS TO NOTE

- In order to facilitate broader engagement Members are limited to serving on a *maximum of 2* of the following committees: **BoT, FIAC, MC and PC** at any one time. Applications submitted where Members are already serving on 2 of these committees will be rejected.
- Any Member already serving on 2 committees who wants to apply for other committees **must resign one or both of their positions in order to apply for another position** (depending on whether they wish to apply for 1 or 2 other committees). The Nomination Form must state which committee(s) the Member is resigning from.
- In order to ensure the independence of FIAC the number of Trustees sitting on FIAC has been limited to a *maximum of 2*, excluding the chair of FIAC. Please note there will be **2 places available for Trustees on FIAC this year.**
