Tips for Skype interviews

- Preparation is Key!
- Speaking of usernames, make sure yours is professional
- Dress the part!
- Maintain eye contact
- Engage with the camera, not your screen!



Interview preparation

- Research the company: products, services, markets, competitors, trends, current activities, priorities.
- Research background of interviewer/hiring manager (if possible)
- Dry run to location, plan your route!
- Prepare suit/smart dress



Interview preparation

- Practice competency based interview questions.
- Know your CV inside out as anything which is on there may come up.
- Practice in front of a mirror.
- Now it's time to get the job!

Social Media

- 75% of hiring managers and recruiters check social media profiles
- 1 of 3 employers have admitted to rejecting candidates based on social media
- 75% of CVs with unprofessional email addresses are rejected



Social media

- Modify privacy settings
- Remove/ hide anything which may put off potential employers
- Most companies have legislation in contracts about employee social media use



Social media – Linked In

- LinkedIn is essentially a professional Facebook
- List work history, education and what you're looking for, key skills
- Many employers use it to advertise/headhunt employees
