Attendees to the meeting are expected to be both academic and industrial colleagues interested in the fundamentals and applications of interfacially-active particle systems.

Adsorption and desorption of particles at liquid-liquid and liquid-gas interfaces have formed an expanding part of colloidal science and technology over the last 15 years. Their applications as emulsion and foam stabilisers are starting to find their way into various formulated products. This meeting will address several different aspects of this topic, including the synthesis of interfacially-active particles, the characterisation of their behaviour at interfaces, their use as Pickering emulsifiers and as building blocks for functional materials

Meeting themes:

The meeting will look at all aspects of particles active at liquid-liquid and liquid-gas interfaces. Particular themes for the meeting will be synthesis of interfacially-active particles, Pickering emulsions and foams and their applications, responsive/functional particles and measurements of particle interactions at interfaces. Submissions in related topics are also encouraged.
